

Elements in Fabric - Earth Supply List

Materials fee: \$20.00 payable to instructor at classtime includes multiple page handout & pattern, plus Angelina and Tintzl fiber; Totally Stable, MistyFuse, cellophane; iridescent cracked ice, Puff Paint tree and rocks, Lutradur, Tyvek, use of fabric paints, Shiva paint sticks; metallic paint powders.

You need to bring:

- Small pieces of fabrics for an Earth scene - for tree trunks, rocks, water, preferably batiks or blurry hand dyes, NOT calicos! Bring blue and white fabrics for the water (8-1/2" x 11"), and a dark forest background (about 11" x 4:"); rocks can be any color, but stay away from pure gray!
- 2-3 Pieces of Lite Steam a Seam II (this now available again at JoAnn's)
- Sheer fabrics - opalescent organdie, or sparkle organza in sheer opalescent and white colors - bring 1/8-1/4 yd or so of whatever fabrics you can find,
- Lots of pins - preferably fine, glass headed pins
- Heat gun (if you have one)
- Tall thin candle, candle holder and matches
- Ultra Fine Sharpie Marker
- One piece each (8-1/2" x 11") of tracing paper (the kind you see through) and freezer paper
- Glue stick
- Stiletto (if you have one)
- Rotary cutter and small Olfa board
- 1 white garbage bag
- Parchment paper (from grocery store)
- Scotch or masking tape
- Fine white iridescent glitter (if you have some)
- A few of paint brushes - 1/4" - 1/2" wide
- 5 or so plastic throw-away cups for paint
- Apron or wear old clothes
