***INSURANCE WAIVER AND ASSUMPTION OF LOSS:**



2019 QUILT SHOW EXHIBITOR'S RECEIPT AND ENTRY LABEL:

1. Retain Page 3 of the Entry Form until you turn in your entry items. On the RECEIPT section, print your name. On the LABEL section, print your name, phone numbers, and entry name.
2. Cut out the LABEL and sew it on the back of your entry item in the lower right-hand corner.
3. Attach a HANGING SLEEVE to the top of your quilts. **Entries without sleeves will be rejected.**
4. When you deliver your **Judged entries** to the Elk Grove Sew 'n' Vacuum Center at 8705 Elk Grove Blvd. on **Thursday, September 12** or your **Exhibited entries** to the SES Hall on **Friday, September 13**, the check-in staff will note the entry number on the RECEIPT and LABEL sections and return the RECEIPT to you.
5. You must present the **EXHIBITOR'S RECEIPT** after the Quilt Show on **Sunday, September 15** to retrieve your entries.

DEFINITION OF CATEGORIES:

- **Pieced Quilt** – Piecing predominates over any other technique.
- **Appliqué Quilt** – Hand or machine appliqué predominates over any other technique.
- **Scrap Quilt** – Quilt top is comprised of at least 25 fabrics or more in any size or technique.
- **Art Quilt** – Must be 100% your original design, created **and** quilted by you, and meant to be used as a piece of Art..
- **Pictorial** – A quilt that represents an image of a person, place or thing and may be from a purchased pattern or design.
- **Other Techniques** – (**Must be Quilted**) Includes whole cloth, embroidery, crazy quilts, folk art, or a combination of techniques.
- **Junior Quilt** – (**Exhibit only with Judges' comments**) Quilt of any size made by anyone who is 17 years old or younger.
- **Wearable Art/ Accessory** A garment, i.e.; jacket, vest, purse, totes; constructed by using any quilting technique.
- **First Judged Quilt** – The first quilt that you have entered in a quilt show to be Judged..
- **Home Décor** – Items for the home, such as table or bed runners, tree skirts, placemats, etc., in any technique.

QUILT SHOW ENTRY GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES

ENTRY FORMS:

- All entry forms (one item per form) must be postmarked no later than Thursday, **July 18, 2019**. Mail to Karen Cannon, c/o Elk Grove Quilt Guild, P.O. Box 1413, Elk Grove, CA 95759, **OR** submit them in person during the July 18, 2019 monthly EGQG meeting.
 - **Please include a color photograph of each entry. Entry will not be accepted if photo is not included.**
 - **If you would like your photo included on the Entry Description Card, please email a 3 x 3" black and white photo to kcbea55@frontiernet.net.**
- All entry forms must be filled out **completely** and must include an address and phone numbers. It is important that we receive all items to be entered in the show by the deadline. The layout of the show is planned from the entry forms and photos received. Please be realistic about what you can finish to avoid last minute withdrawals.

ENTRIES:

1. Each Guild member may enter a total of **eight** items to be exhibited of which **four** may be judged.
2. Non-Guild members may enter "Exhibit Only" entries if space permits.
3. Items must be quilted, made of fabric, finished, clean, and in good condition.
4. Quilts **must** have a four-inch sleeve on the upper back. (See directions on page 5 of 5)
5. All entries **must** have the attached label sewn or pinned to the lower right corner of the back of the entry.
6. Photography will be allowed during the show.
7. Please deliver your **Judged and Junior entries** to the Elk Grove Sew 'n' Vacuum Center, 8705 Elk Grove Boulevard, Elk Grove, on Thursday, September 12 between 8:30 a.m. and 9:30 a.m.
8. Please deliver your **Exhibited entries** to the SES Hall, 10428 East Stockton Blvd, Elk Grove, on Friday, September 13 between 8:30 a.m. and 10:00 a.m.
9. All items must be picked up on Sunday, September 15, 2019 (after the show) between 5:00p.m. and 6:00 p.m. You must present your exhibitor's receipt in order to pick up your entry. No items will be released until all items are taken down, no exceptions.

JUDGING GUIDELINES:

- Only Elk Grove Quilt Guild members in good standing as of July 18, 2019 may enter items to be exhibited in the Quilt Show.
- Each paid member may enter up to **four** entries for judging, but only **two** items per category.
- All judged entries must have been made by the exhibitor.
- All entries submitted for judging must include a \$10 fee (cash or check) per item.
- Quilts judged in previous Elk Grove Guild quilt shows are ineligible.
- 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place, and Honorable Mention ribbons may be awarded in each category at the sole discretion of the judges.
- In addition, judges may award the following Optional Special Awards: Best Hand Quilting, Best Machine Quilting, Best Use of Color, Best of Show, and each judge may award a Judge's Choice.
- The judges reserve the right to re-categorize any item or disqualify any item from the judging portion of the show.

DIRECTIONS FOR ADDING A 4" HANGING SLEEVE TO A FINISHED QUILT

- Fabric for the hanging sleeve can be the same fabric used for the quilt back, muslin or whatever the quilter chooses.
- Cut a piece of fabric the width of your quilt x 9" long.
- Hem the 9" ends of the fabric strip by folding under a 1/2", ironing, then folding and ironing again. Sew close to the edge of the hem.
- Fold the fabric in half lengthwise, wrong sides together, and sew the length of the fabric with a 1/2" seam allowance to create a sleeve.
- Center the sleeve's lengthwise seam facing the quilt back and pin the top of the sleeve approximately 1" below the binding. Allow for a slight outward pucker in the sleeve when pinning the bottom edge to the quilt back. This extra fullness on the sleeve will accommodate the rod and prevent a bulge on the front of the quilt when the quilt is hung
- Blind stitch the top edge of the sleeve to the quilt back. To reduce the pull on the quilt back fabric, catch some of the batting in the stitches. Avoid stitching through the quilt top.
- Blind stitch the bottom edge of the sleeve to the quilt back.
- The sleeve may also be sewn on between the quilt back and binding when the binding is sewn on. It may also be pinned to the back of the quilt. However, if the sleeve is pinned, the weight of the hanging quilt could cause the pins to create holes in the quilt backing. The Elk Grove Quilt Guild will not be liable for any damage caused by the pins used to attach the sleeve.
