

Easy Panel Quilt

Finished as pictured approximately 41X50

Yardage:

- ¼ yard center panel
- 1/3 yard small inner borders
- 32 assorted 4 inch squares
- 1 yard outer border and binding

Cutting Instructions:

Center Piece: Cut into one rectangle 19 ½ x 26 ½

4 inch squares: Subcut 4 inch strips into 4 inch squares

You will have extra squares so you can create your preferred layout

Inner Borders: Cut 8 strips 1 ½ inches the WOF (width of fabric)

Outer Border and Binding: Cut 5 6 ½ inch strips.

Binding: Cut five strips 2 ½ inches WOF



Note: Measure the sides and top through the center of the quilt to get measurement of the borders.

Stitch the sides first and then the top.

Sewing Instructions:

1. Sew first 1 ½ inch inner borders around the center panel.
2. Sew 4 rows of 4 inch squares together, 8 per row.
3. Sew 4 inch square rows to center panel.
4. Sew 1 ½ inch border around the 4 inch square border.
5. Sew 6 ½ inch borders around the 4 inch square border.
6. Quilt and bind with binding included in kit.
