Come enjoy a day of painting and having fun with friends. We will each paint a canvas with acrylic paints. Check out the web for inspiration on your chosen design for your “barn quilt”.

## Supplies:

- Buy a canvas. They come in various sizes, from 12x12 to 20x20 inches. (Available at Michaels & Hobby Lobby) Our samples are 14x14 and 18x18 inches.
- Michaels has a 4-pack so you might want to share with a buddy)
- Watch for Hobby Lobby’s & Michael’s ad to get a good discount.

Bring an apron or wear clothes that you don’t mind getting messy!

Bring lunch/drink. We will be outside at Kathy Sansone’s house.

Bring a hat, we will be outside.

Bring a small easel or box to prop your canvas on.

Paint supplies, brushes, tape will be brought to the class by us.

We ask that you pick out the design for your canvas and have it marked prior to class. We recommend that you use pencil if you plan on medium to dark paint colors or use chalk pencil (Roxanne’s Quilter’s Choice-Silver) for pastel paint colors. Google block designs or barn quilt designs to get an idea. I recommend that you keep your choice on the simple side, consider this to be practice for larger or a wooden version.
