

# KITE QUILT DESCRIPTION

Very easy beginner quilt.

This strip quilt is made with multiple fabrics or fabric's in holiday theme or otherwise. A template is used to cut the Kites which will be available to purchase or use in class.

The sample shown can be either a table runner or a small quilt. The directions here are for a sixteen block square quilt (which will finish approx.. 48x48). The table runner is with eight squares (finishes at pprox.. 23x41). Both have borders. The yardage for the table runner can be cut in half i.e. ½ to ½ but the 1/8<sup>th</sup> remain the same, you will just have strips left.

## KITE STRIP QUILT CLASS SUPPLY LIST Elk Grove Quilt Club Date:

Sewing Machine Thread

Cutting Mat

Ironing mat and small iron

Scissors

Elmer's purple glue stick (or fabric glue)

Fabric cutter the large one works best with the templates'

Cutting ruler at least 12 inches in length

Binding tool (optional)

Something to drink and lunch if you want. Refrigerator, microwave and toaster oven available.

### **Fabric Requirements**

Light weight pellon (I use 120-11102) ¾ yard for 8 blocks, 1 ½ yard for 16 blocks. I use 830 easy patterns by pellon (yellow label) I will also bring a supply if you are unable to find it.

#### Kite is your focus fabric, ¼ yard for 8, ½ yard for 16. I have templates.

The fabric listed is for 16 blocks. Or your stash of strips.

6 coordinated fabrics as follows: (each strip has a number)

Strip 1, 1/2 yard

Strip 2, 1/2 yard

Strip 3, ¼ yard

Strip 4, 1/8 yard

Strip 5, 1/8 yard

Strip 6, 1/8 yard

Borders ½ yard

Backing and binding, 1 ½ yards, with some leftover.

#### The fabric listed is for 8 block table runner.

6 coordinated fabrics as follows: (each strip has a number)

Strip 1, ¼ yard

Strip 2, 1/2 yard

Strip 3, ¼ yard

Strip 4, 1/8 yard

Strip 5, 1/8 yard

Strip 6, 1/8 yard

Borders ½ yard

Backing and binding 1 yard.
