## Chain Link



Finished band is about 5 1/2" x 40"

## Fabric

You will need two contrasting fabrics for the Chain Link band.

- Fabric A Cut (5) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips (chain)
- Fabric B Cut (5) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips (background)

## Construction

- Sew two strips sets: A-B-A and B-A-B Press both seam allowances in the same direction
- Cut set A-B-A into (8) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" segments
- Cut set B-A-B into (9) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" segments
- Sew the segments to strips of fabric A
- Trim sections Press toward fabric A
- Join one large section with one small section
  Press toward fabric A
- Join pairs into a band Press toward fabric A
- Sew a strip of fabric B to the top and bottom of the chain Press toward fabric B

## Challenge

Make a mini band using 1" x 22" strips (fat quarters work great for this). Cut (7) fabric A strips and (5) fabric B strips. Cut set A-B-A into (11) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " segments and cut set B-A-B into (12) 1" segments. Finished band is about 3" x 30".
