Approximate size: 40 x 46

Diagram 1



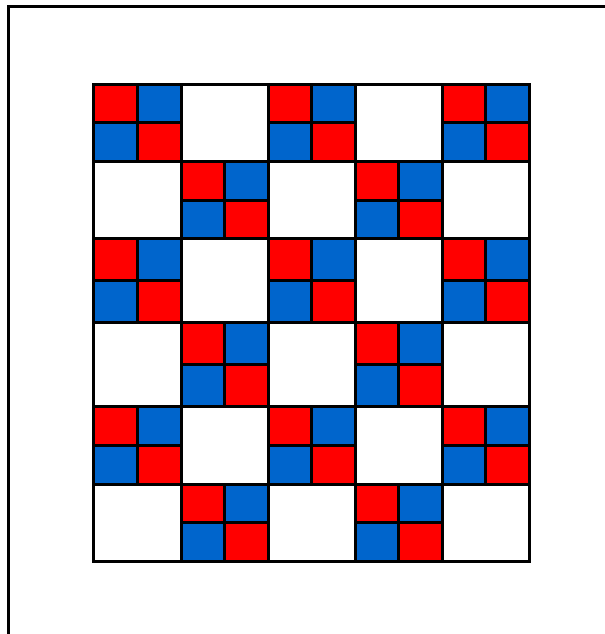
Yardage Requirements

3/4 yard main fabric

3/8 yard second fabric

5/8 yard third fabric

Diagram 2



- 1) main fabric: cut 3 strips 3 1/2" x wof (four-patch)
cut 4 strips 5" x wof (outer border)
- 2) second fabric cut 3 strips 3 1/2" x wof (four-patch)
- 3) third fabric cut 3 strips 6 1/2" x wof
sub-cut into 15 6 1/2 squares

Sewing Instructions

- 1) Sew three 3 1/2" strips from each main fabric and second fabric
Diagram 1. Press and subcut into 30 3 1/2" sections
- 2) Sew to make 15 four-patch squares, should measure 6 1/2"
- 3) Sew the four-patch squares and the 6 1/2" squares, alternating
to form the patterns in Diagram 2.
- 4) Measure outer borders to size of quilt. Sew side borders first
and top borders second.
- 5) Sew on binding to complete the quilt.
